Early Identification by Class Teacher and referral to SENCo

Assessment by SENCo – referral to outside agencies as necessary.

What does the school do if my child has SEN/D?

Individual education 'My Plans' to set targets for teaching

Commonly asked questions.

What happens if my child has an EHC plan?
Regular person-centred review for provision and support.

Tracking children with SEN/D to ensure progress and support in place

Monitoring and reviewing needs through structured conversations.

If my child needs additional support beyond their education speak to Mrs Dowle.

Additional support agencies

What additional service providers does the school access to meet the needs of my child?

Further support from Educational Inclusion Team. Also referrals to Occupational Therapy Service.

Teaching strategies Assess, Plan, Do and Review to support progress.

Regular meetings with school, support agencies and parents/carers.

Speech and Language Therapy; School Nursing Team; Paediatrician; Children and Young Peoples Service, Young Minds Matter.
